You can also help by making jams or preserves, potting up plants to sell, or think about baking cakes, slices and biscuits.



4. The Maharashtra cluster leader's wife has been suffering with a kidney stone. She has twice had treatment and will again need surgery to seek relief from here severe pain this month.
5. The Nasik cluster leader Santosh and his team praise God for the baptisms which took place on 29th. 15 recent converts received baptism. We thank God for this harvest.
