The team is about to leave Australia for another year at Horizont camp, the camp we have been going to for 10 years! Daniel Van der Spuy is team leader this year. He has fellow Grace CRC members Cecile, Tarbie and Yolande as well as his friend Adriaan and Natasha from Gateway CRC on his team. They have been preparing together since March this year. The program (theme is the Olympics) is ready, craft materials and gifts collected and visas have been issued.

They leave this Friday, June 24th, and on Monday, 27th, they will arrive at the camp where they will be until July 15.

Please keep them in your prayers. There are some uncertainties this year as during the winter camp the main administration building was burnt down. This also housed many of the camp staff members, so the team is not sure where they will be housed this year, yet we praise God that the camp staff really wanted to have the Aussie team despite the difficulties in the camp.

Pray for health; for unity in the team; for many opportunities to share the Gospel.

Pray for the children and adults who will receive Bibles on parent's day. Another praise point is that an organization in St Petersburg is donating the Bibles this year. This is a huge saving for the team and also the reason the CRC has not been asked to help finance them this year!

Pray for the interpreters, Natalie and Ilona, as they work and live with the team.

Pray for safety while travelling and that all the luggage will arrive intact as the craft items are among the luggage.

For me it will be bitter sweet as the team leaves. It will be strange to stay at home during July after 12 years, but it is a joy to see that the work in Russia will continue! Praise God!
