Meditation

In Mark 2:27, Jesus says the Sabbath is one of God's gifts to us. The idea that Sabbath-keeping can be a delight can be surprising to people who know the Sabbath only as a day filled with restrictions, obligations and taboos. As a result, many people who felt stifled by the Sabbath as children have switched to enjoying "the weekend" instead. It sounds like a more freeing and refreshing option. But too often "the weekend" doesn't deliver on its promises. Many people drag themselves back to work on Monday from yet another frantic weekend more exhausted than they were on Friday.

Why is Sabbath-keeping a pause that truly invigorates? Because it is an invitation to discover our true rest in Jesus Christ. As Lord of the Sabbath, Jesus assures us that our security is not found in a non-stop schedule of work and weekend getaways. Our confidence and peace are found in Jesus' resurrection victory – a victory we celebrate every Sunday as we experience a taste of the fulfilled Sabbath. Centre your Sabbath in worship that celebrates Christ's resurrection victory. Salt your Sabbath with times of fellowship, meditation, and reflection. Discover that setting apart one day a week for worship and rest makes the whole week go better. (Today, May 22, 2005)


To the congregation, a total of \$653.30 was raised for the Leprosy Mission.
