Meditation

For much of this letter that Paul wrote to Titus, the focus has been on the ethical and moral implications that come from following Jesus Christ as Lord. He has spelled out in some detail what making the gospel of our Lord and Saviour attractive looks like: elders who are above reproach, rebellious people that are to be silenced, proper teaching and life for old and young alike, families and workers.

The reasons and motivation for such living are obvious: to renounce evil and live godly, disciplined lives in this present age comes from the gospel of grace: the grace that brings salvation; the grace that restores and empowers believers; the grace that looks forward to the return of our Saviour and the vindication of all that is true: in fact, the true outworking of a people that belong to Jesus, eager to do what is good. Such living is part of God's plan of redemption, a life that is lived for Christ in sheer joy and gratitude for all He has done for us and given to us.

Pastoral

This morning after the service we will be holding our AGM, an opportunity to consider our budget, as well as discuss any other questions or considerations that impact our congregation as a whole. We do so in trust upon the Lord, knowing He is the one who is faithful and the One who so far has supplied all our needs according to His riches in glory.

Let us not forget those who struggle constantly with weakness, health and age; especially those who are unable to attend regularly — if you have the opportunity give them a call or pop in for a visit, and remember them in your prayers.

2016 Census
