Meditation

"...and I fear the Lord...what shall we do to you?" Jonah 1: 9b&11b

Your life testifies to the creeds you make.

The pagan captain had to shake him up to the shame of Jonah. Jonah wakes up, church of Christ wakes up! For Gentiles, Jonah did not want to bring the Word of God. Now he cannot do anything else. He was driven in a corner, deep in his heart he knows: it is for his sake that this storm rage, it is God who speaks through the powers of nature. Jonah is guilty. Without confessing his sins Jonah immediately enters into a confession of faith. Jonah confesses: I fear the Lord, the God of heaven, who made the sea and the dry land. What a miracle confession.

But dear Reader, is it not very easy to make a "word" confession?

It is very difficult to live what we confess. It is not easy to show our faith through our works to the world by word and deed. We all have a piece of Jonah in us. How often do we not sleep? How often does the world shake us with the words: your life is not a testimony of what you believe and confess. The Lord speaks to everybody today by the disobedient prophet, Jonah: LIVE your confession that Jesus is your King in all areas of life. If you do, the storms will bury your boat, yes, storms in your marriage, your work, your relationships, your heart, your congregation and wherever you go.

What do we do if the world is distressed?
